General Academic Scholarship Instructions

PAYABLE: When the Lodge is notified of official enrollment in school or August 2022, whichever is later, the payment will be made directly to the student's account at the school of their choice. All 2022 scholarships must be claimed by August 31, 2023 or are forfeited.

Qualifications and Instructions

- 1. Open to all Lincoln and surrounding area high school seniors residing in the Lincoln Elks Lodge #80 jurisdiction. In the case of students attending out-of-town schools, parents must reside in the Lincoln Elks Lodge #80 jurisdiction. Jurisdiction is determined by Zip Code via <u>Elks Lodge Locator</u>- Lincoln Lodge #80 must be listed as "A".
- 2. The Academic Scholarship Selection Form is the first page of each application. PRINT IT.
 - A. <u>Category "A" Scholarships</u> check the box beside each Category "A" scholarship(s) for which you are eligible. Add your name and make this the first page of your application. Only one application is necessary to be considered for all Category "A" scholarships.
 - B. <u>Category "B" Scholarships</u> check the box beside ONE Category "B" scholarship for which you wish to apply. A separate complete application must be submitted for each Category "B" Scholarship or Scholarship Group. Add your name and make this the first page of your application.
- 3. Complete the application in full Each application must include (preferably assembled in this order) the Academic Scholarship Selection Form, all pages of the application, two letters of recommendation, the parents' financial statement and official sealed transcript.
- 4. Some scholarships require that you enroll in a defined course of study in college. Winners of these scholarships will be required to provide evidence of enrollment from their college counselor or financial aid office that confirms enrollment in that defined course of study.
- 5. All applications will be judged on the basis of academic achievement, leadership, financial need, and other information as requested. *Incomplete applications will not be considered.*
- 6. All information submitted in the application is solely for the use of Lincoln Elks Lodge #80 Scholarship Committee. Decisions made by the Committee are final and may not be appealed.
- 7. All applications must be signed and dated as required. The financial data page must be signed by the parent or guardian and be attached to the application when submitted. All required components of the application must be attached together. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 8. All completed applications must be received at the Lincoln Elks Lodge #80 by 5:30 pm on January 29, 2022 to be eligible for consideration. NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BE SURE TO CONSIDER MAILING TIME! There will be a drop box located in the west entryway of the Lodge at 5910 S. 58th Street that will be accessible during lodge hours. Hours are posted at <u>elks80.org</u>.
- 9. Winners will be posted at <u>elks80.org</u>, by April 15, 2022, and will also be notified by mail. Winners are invited to be recognized at Youth Night ceremonies held at Southeast Community College on the evening of May 02, 2022.
