- Scholarship Amounts:** \$1,000 per year for 4 years .
- Payable:** When the Lodge Secretary is notified of official enrollment in school, the payment will be made directly to the student's account at the school of their choice.

### Qualifications and Instructions

1. Open to all Lincoln and surrounding area high school students.
2. Complete the application blanks in full - **all questions must be answered. Attach other requested information to the application.**
3. Be certain that the application is signed and dated as requested. The financial data page must be signed by the parent or guardian and included by the applicant before mailing or delivering to the Elks Lodge.
4. Indicate the scholarship for which the applicant is eligible and applying.
5. All applications will be judged on the basis of scholarship, leadership, need and other information as requested. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
6. All completed applications must be received at the Lincoln Elks Lodge #80 by 5:30 pm on January 29, 2022 to be eligible for consideration. **NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED - BE SURE TO CONSIDER MAILING TIME!**
7. **ALL INFORMATION SUBMITTED IN THE APPLICATION IS SOLELY FOR THE USE LINCOLN ELKS LODGE #80 SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE.** Decisions made by the Committee are final and may not be appealed.
8. Winners will be notified by mail, and will also be posted on the General Academic Scholarship web page, by April 15, 2022. Winners are invited to be recognized at the Youth Night ceremonies held at Southeast Community College on the evening of May 02, 2022.

## SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

### TEACHING AWARDS

1. **Durst Family Teaching Scholarship.** \$4,000 - \$1,000 per year for 4 years . To qualify a student must have a minimum ACT score of 25 or minimum SAT of 1150. The award winner can renew this scholarship for four year-period under the following conditions:
  - a. Student must remain in pursuit of a degree in Elementary or Secondary Education Program.
  - b. Student must maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.1 or equivalent.
  - c. Student must maintain a full-time student status.
  - d. Student must provide the Lincoln Elks Lodge #80 confirmation from the college or university (may be provided by Department Chair or counselor) which verifies the previous conditions.

**Applicants for this scholarship must add to the application form, a 1-2 page original, hand-written statement about their goals for themselves, their students and their profession.**

Awards will be sent directly to the school/institution to which the winning student enrolls upon receipt of the form provided to the recipient. No awards will be paid directly to the individual. It is the recipient's responsibility to provide proof of satisfaction of the above criteria each year to receive a renewal payment. An official transcript showing course history, grades, GPA and the next semester course registration will suffice.
