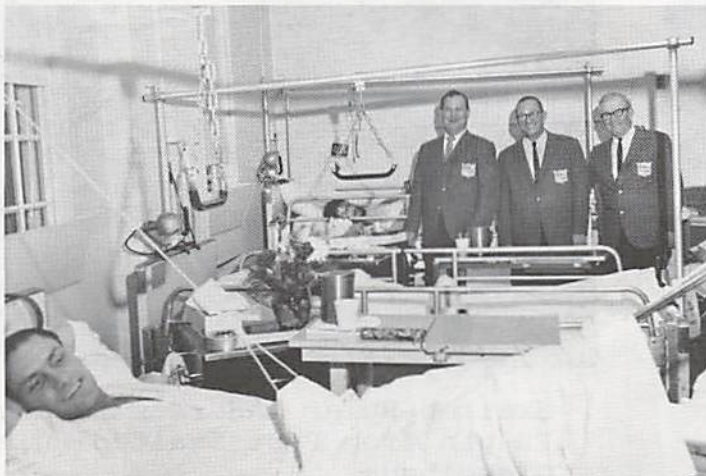
Steve was born in Nebraska City, Nebraska in 1949. Raised on a farm west of Dunbar. He attended and graduated from Syracuse High School.

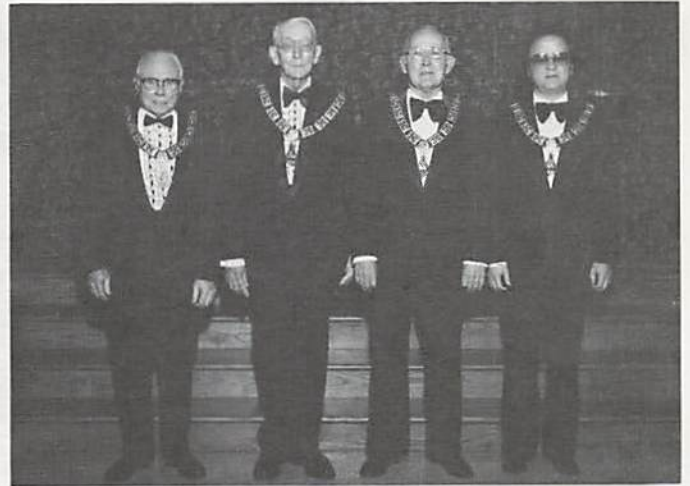
