

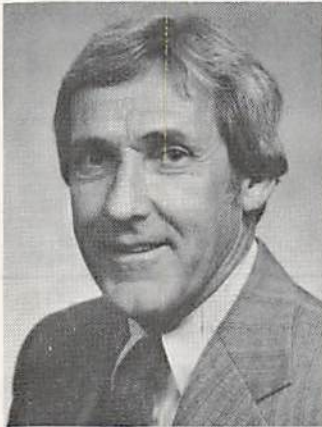

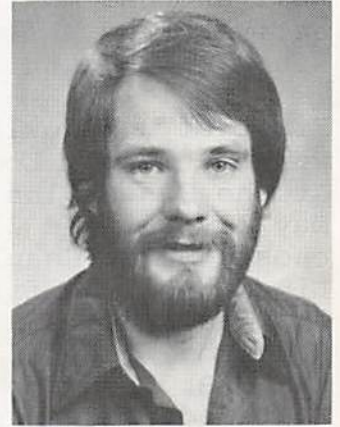
ABOUT YOUR CLUB
