**ELIGIBILITY / REQUIREMENTS**

Any child or grandchild of an elected, appointed and installed officer of an active lodge in the state is eligible for this award. Great-grandchildren are not eligible.

Applicants must be high school seniors and must take the SAT or ACT by December 31 of their senior year. This scholarship may be used at any of the following post high school institutions: 4 year college, 2 year college, community college, beauty college, etc.

**Amount and Number Awarded**

The Nebraska Elks Association Benevolence Commission will award 1(one) \$1,000 scholarship per year.

**Applications**

Beginning September 1, 2011, applications will be available from the NEA Benevolence Commission Chairman or through your local lodge.

**Evaluation**

Judging is based on scholarship, leadership activities. An independent selection committee, appointed by the Nebraska Elks Association Benevolence Committee will judge the applications.

4. Attach a summary of leadership, school and community activities.
5. Please attach a billfold size picture of yourself.
