They are open to students whose sponsoring relative is an active member or deceased member of the Lincoln (NE) Elks Lodge #80. Judging criteria will include the applicant's civic activity, leadership, leadership development, and academic success. Additionally, the applicant's honors and awards and will be considered.

The following eligibility requirements apply for this contest:

1. Any child or grandchild (or step-child, step-grandchild) of a living member of the Lincoln Elks Lodge #80 who has been active the past three (3) years, or a deceased lodge member who had been an active member of Lincoln Elks Lodge #80 for at least ten (10) consecutive years prior to his or her death.
2. The applicant must be a high school graduate, or a high school senior who will graduate within 9 months from the date of this application.
3. Applicants must be under the age of 25 by the date of this application.
4. Applicant must apply through the Lincoln Elks Lodge, regardless of where the applicant resides.
5. Students will submit one application to be considered for these scholarships.
6. These awards may only be paid to accredited US American schools, colleges or universities.
7. Make a photocopy of your application for your records. All applications become the property of Lincoln Elks Lodge #80.
8. The student and the sponsoring Elk must complete their respective sections.
9. All applications will be judged on the basis of scholarship, leadership, need, and other information as requested. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
10. All completed applications must be received at the Lincoln Elks Lodge #80 by 7:00 pm on December 30, 2025 to be eligible for consideration. **NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED - BE SURE TO CONSIDER MAILING TIME!**

1. **Your Schooling**

5. **Your Activities, Honors and Awards**

The following is a list to assist in completion of the Honors and Awards section. Include awards such as Eagle Scout; Gold Award; Teen of the Year; Statewide or National Conferences (ex: Boy's/Girl's State, HOBY); major athletic award; and major academic award. • **Transcript and SAT/ACT Scores**

Include official, complete, current high school transcript of student grades through your junior year. Transcript may be a photocopy that bears the original signature of the proper school authority.

SAT or ACT test scores must be included, but may be photocopies. Use one set of ACT scores only, and/or up to two sets of SAT scores. It is not necessary to send a separate sheet of test scores if they are included on your transcript. However, it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the scores are listed on the transcript.

• **Letters of Recommendation**

Include two letters of recommendation. One must be from a high school teacher. If you are already in college, please have an educator from your college or university write the recommendation. The other may be from a high school teacher, professor, or responsible community member. The authors of the letters may not be related to you. The letters may cover your ability, work habits, leadership skills, participation in the community, work service, outstanding recognition, personality and integrity. Letters may be originals or photocopies but must be limited to one side of a single sheet (8.5-by-11-inch) of paper, typed, dated and signed by the author.

• **Special Instructions For Post-High School Applicants:**

We encourage all applicants who have already graduated from high school to provide as much information as possible in order for the selection committee to give you maximum consideration. Please fill in as many blanks as possible, even though you may have graduated from high school five or six years earlier. Your activities while you were in high school, as well as after you graduated, are very important to us. You should include high school and college transcripts, or any other official records you have.
