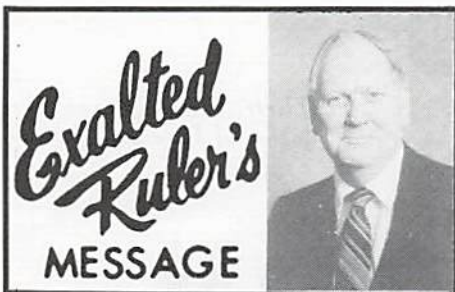

Dear Brothers:

Our new building is proceeding a little slower than anticipated, however we still have the same target date for moving. I hope all of you are looking forward to our move to 5910 S. 58th as much as your Officers and Trustees are. Here we will be cost efficient enough to eliminate all of the money plaguing times we have had for the past 15 years. The future looks bright for members and our new Lodge home.

The enclosed Resolution to be voted on August 1st is for money to finish the interior of our new home. As of this date we do not have firm estimates on the balance of the interior costs. The money we are requesting you to approve may be too much, however you can be assured that your Trustees will not spend any money which is not absolutely necessary for us to have the new home we all want. We ask you to show your confidence in us by supporting this Resolution.

We may be able to reduce or even eliminate the need for a small loan if a few more Brothers help and volunteer as some have already done.

Brothers Paul Goetowski and George Klein have pledged another \$500.00 each.

Brother Larry Sintek has pledged a Grease Trap, its installation and a Bar Sink.

Brother Bud Lehl has pledged floor tile for the restrooms.

Brother Dan Holmstedt has pledged the electrical service panels.

Brother Jim McGee (Square D) has pledged all needed circuit breakers.

In the past 5 years, Brothers have contributed in excess of \$100,000 to the Building Fund. Without these donations, it would have been impossible to acquire a new location. The names of these donors appear on a plaque in the Lodge. "Look it over", space available.

The Facility Committee is looking for additional Brothers who will help to complete our new Lodge home. If other Brothers help we will certainly have the capability of moving without a loan. Brothers Bud Dietrich and Bill Woltemade have surveyed our current building and we know what we can use, but there are additional new items required. Please contact an Officer, Trustee, or member of the Facility Committee and volunteer your help and support.



Be it moved that the following resolution be mailed to all members by letter and be voted upon at the regular lodge meeting of August 1, 1990.

Be it resolved that the Trustees of Lincoln Lodge #80 be authorized to spend up to \$90,000 to complete the interior and signs of the new lodge building to be located at 5910 So. 58th St. \$40,000 plus donations and interest will come from Building Funds. The balance as needed to be acquired through a loan negotiated by the Trustees at an interest rate of not more than Prime Rate plus 2½% and for a period of time not to exceed 20 years.

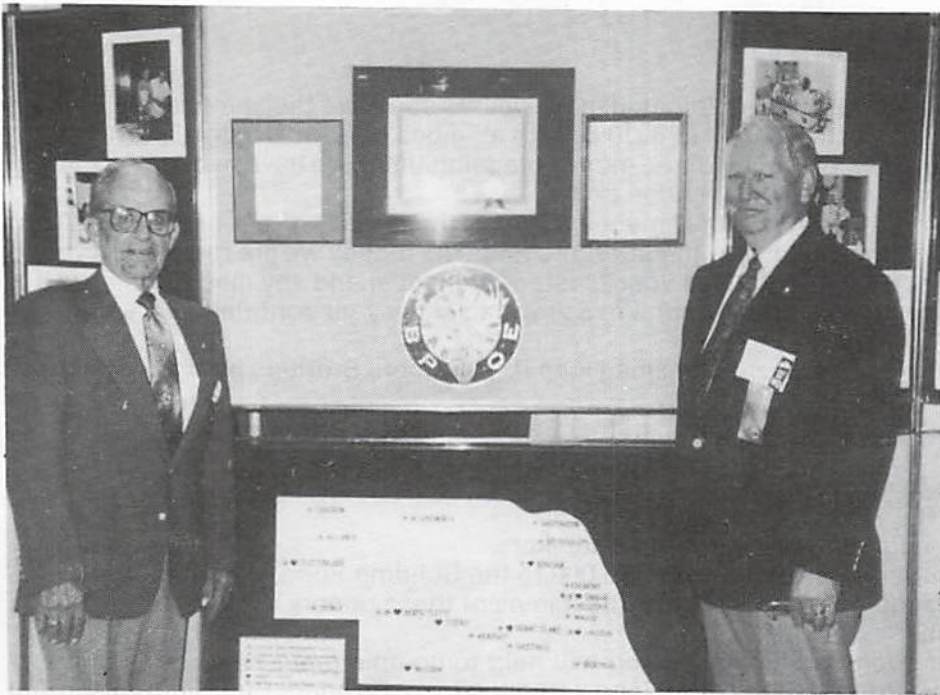

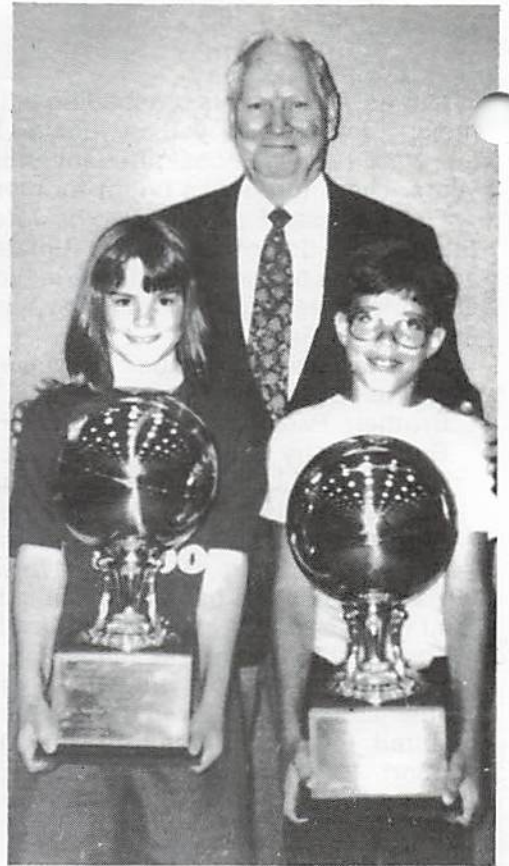
